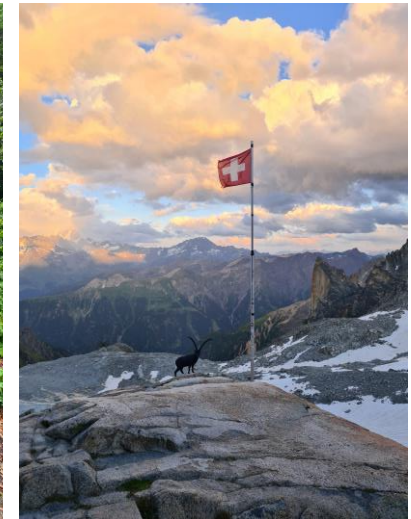

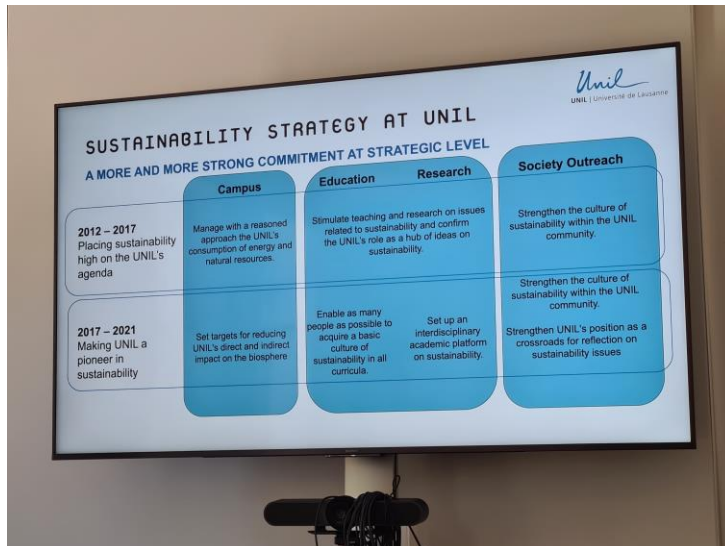
Sustainability and Leadership; Switzerland, July 2024

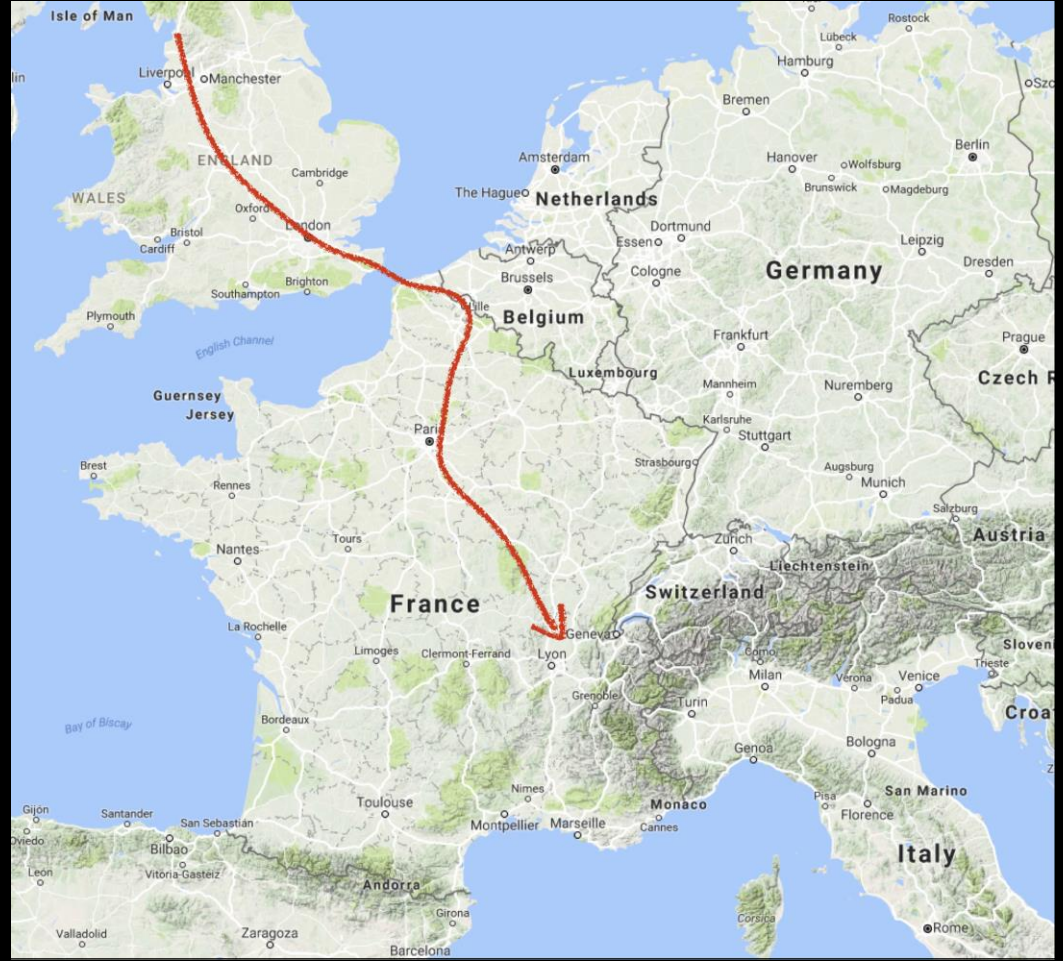

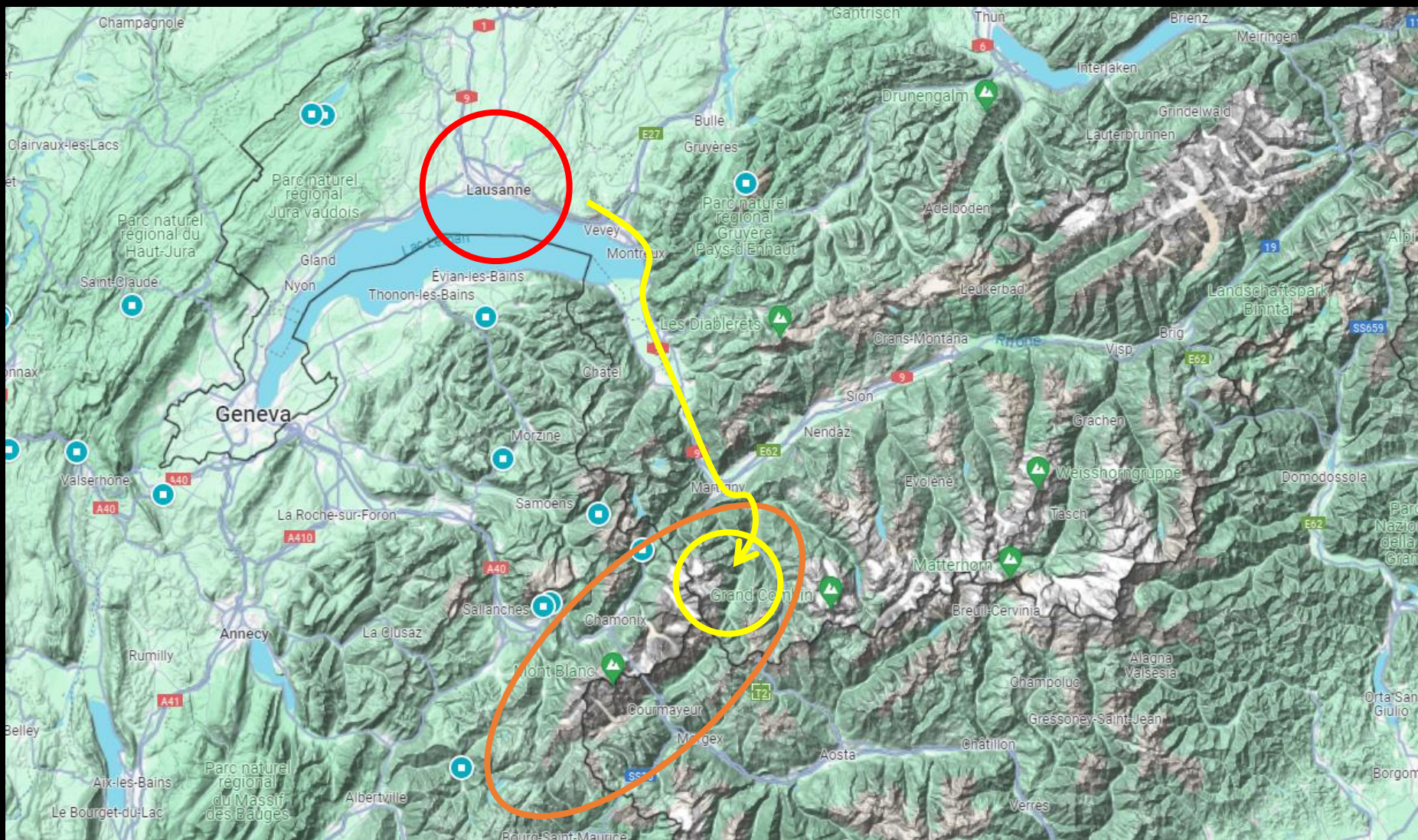

2-Day Mountain Trekking

- Swiss Valais, eastern end of Mont-Blanc massif
- Set out from Champex-Lac, alpine village at 1,400 m
- Take chairlift to 2,200 m 'La Breya'
- Walk along balcony footpath above Combe d'Orny followed by moraine leading to Cabane d'Orny
- Cab. d'Orny is located at 2,825 m, perched on the lateral moraine above Glacier d'Orny
- Distance = 5 km, ascent 700 m.


