ASSESSOR/INTERLOCUTOR TRAINING (SPEAKING)

AIMS

- Provide information about Speaking exams
- Familiarise participants with the principles and procedures of conducting Speaking exams and assessing the performances

- Ensure valid and reliable assessment of live performances through standardisation.
