## Hull Children's Flood Project

### Learning from young people about flooding and flood recovery

Following on from the floods in Hull in June 2007 this project worked with a group of flood-affected children and young people to find out about their experiences of flooding and the flood recovery process. We asked the participants to draw pictures and write about their experiences to illustrate their flood journey in the form of a 'storyboard'. We then conducted interviews with each participant to learn more about their individual stories. The research identifies key issues in young people's experiences, the roles they played in the recovery process and the implications for the future. It will contribute to an archive being generated about the floods in Hull so that the voices of young people will become part of the flooding debate and the assessment of future research and policy.


