Before you set off, print off your ticket or download it to your phone.



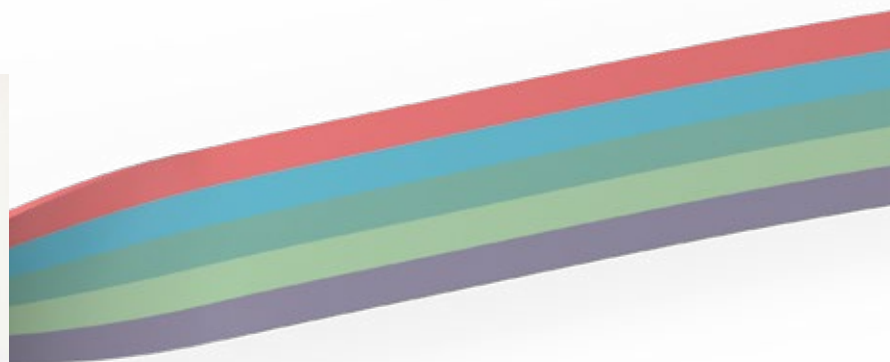
When you have arrived on campus visit one of our check-in points located at with County South Lecture Theatre (Map Ref COS) or Charles Carter Building (Map Ref CHC).

Colleges and Accommodation

Lancaster is proud to be one of only a handful of UK universities to have a collegiate system. We have nine colleges in total, eight for undergraduate students and one for postgraduate students.

Colleges are centred on our wide range of award-winning accommodation to suit different preferences and budgets.

Student Based Services and Careers

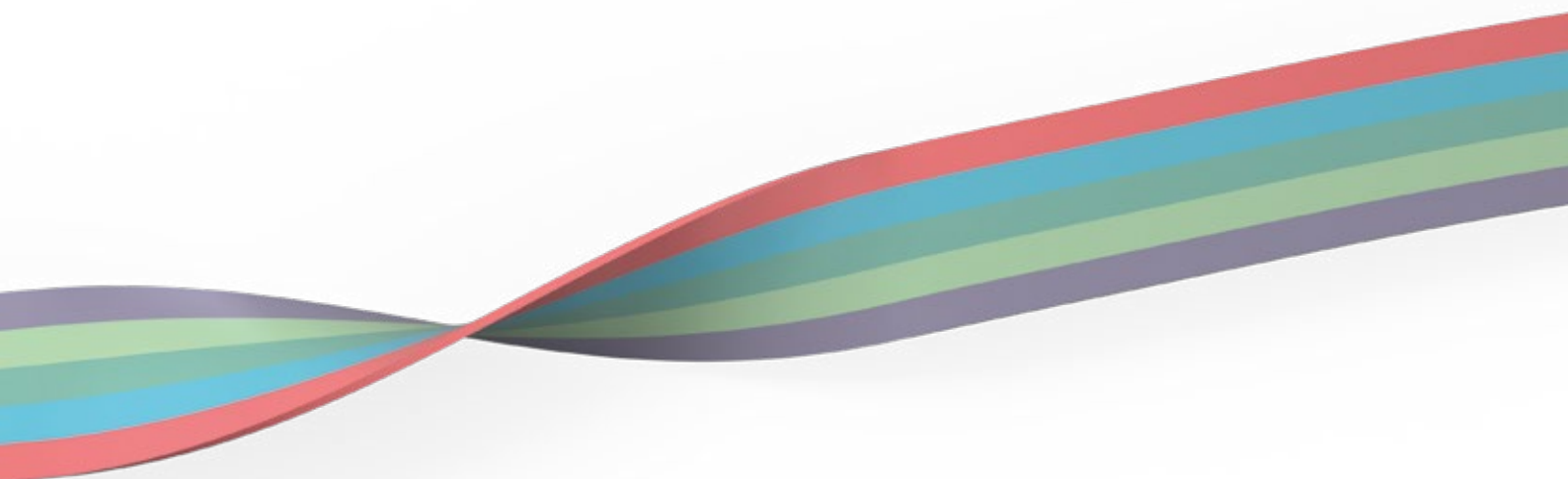
