

Car Parking on Campus

Visitors should use the Pay and Display parking. Scratchcards may also be used in pay and display areas (see below).

Please note that all permit parking rules, visitor charges and parking enforcement operate during vacation periods as well as during University term-times.

Locations

Visitor car parks are in the following locations.

1. Farrer Avenue 72 spaces
2. South Drive 56 spaces
3. Bowland Avenue 92 spaces
4. Management School 35 spaces
5. Whewell Building 6 spaces
6. North Drive visitor car park 24 spaces

Visitors displaying a pay and display ticket or a scratch card may park in the Staff Preference, Staff Standard or Student Standard zones if space is not available in visitor car parking areas.

Charges

Pay and display tickets will cost £1 for 2 hours, £2 for 4 hours and £3 for a day. They will be available from pay and display machines located in car parks 1-3 above. Pay and display tickets are also valid in car parks 1-4 & 6 as well as on the southern apron of Alexandra Park.

Scratch cards cost £3 each. They will normally be purchased by individual visitors from the Security Office. Departments may also purchase scratchcards from the Security Office and sell them on to visitors at cost, provided this does not introduce a new requirement to handle cash. Alternatively if a visitor is eligible to claim travel expenses departments may simply provide a scratchcard to the visitor free of charge. Scratch cards should not be posted out to visitors unless they are known to be arriving by car, as visitors travelling by other means will not require them.
