

David R. Sorensen is Professor of English at Saint Joseph's University, Philadelphia. Since 1998 he has been one of the senior editors of the Duke–Edinburgh *Collected Letters of Thomas and Jane Welsh Carlyle* (Duke University Press, 1970–to present, 35 vols.). He has co–edited, with K.J. Fielding, editions of Carlyle's *French Revolution* (Oxford, 1989) and *The Newly Selected Letters of Jane Welsh Carlyle* (Ashgate, 2004), as well as (with Rodger L. Tarr) a collection of essays, *The Carlyles At Home and Abroad* (Ashgate, 2004). He is presently co-editing a variorum edition of Carlyle's *The French Revolution* for the Strouse edition of Carlyle's works, published by the University of California Press. Since 2006, he has also served as co-editor of *Carlyle Studies Annual*, published by Saint Joseph's University Press.
