Glasgow Cinemas of the 1930s Audio Walking Tour

A walking tour around the sites of some of Glasgow's most popular cinemas in the 1930s, led by Professor Annette Kuhn and featuring interviews with cinemagoers from the period. This tour can either be followed on site or at home using the accompanying map (overleaf).

The map was created by Tom McGoran, a former projectionist who started out working as a spool boy in cinemas in Glasgow in the 1930s. You will also hear Tom's memories of Glasgow cinemas included in the walking tour
