

## Criteria for Peer Review of Proposals

### Single Paper Proposals

Single paper proposals will be reviewed using the following criteria:

1. Relevance of the topic to the conference theme
2. Explicit engagement with the issues raised in one or more of the think pieces provided by the keynote speakers
3. Robustness of the analytical or theoretical framework
4. Clarity of the research questions or focus of enquiry
5. Appropriateness of research methods and literature used
6. Reflexive discussion of the significance of the paper

### Symposium Proposals

Symposium proposals will be reviewed using the following criteria:

1. Relevance of the topic to the conference theme
2. Explicit engagement with the issues raised in one or more of the think pieces provided by the keynote speakers
3. Coherence of the different elements of the symposium
4. Robustness of the analytical or theoretical framework(s)
5. Clarity of the research questions or foci of enquiry
6. Appropriateness of research methods and/or literature used
7. Reflexive discussion of the significance of the papers and/or the symposium as a whole.
8. Effective use of the 90 minute time slot
