Dear BHS Community,

I hope this finds you all well.

Given the financial hardships that many are currently experiencing, I've been thinking long and hard about ways to help student and ECR members of the community attend both the BHS 2022 Symposium at Lancaster University, and the Peter Wolf Symposium at the University of Strathclyde in September.

I've specifically chosen to target the student/ECR community because these are often the members within BHS that do not have access to funding sources and are most likely to benefit from the networking opportunities and exposure to the new and exciting research that is presented at both events.

Historically, BHS Travel grants have not been made available for domestic events. I've taken the decision to make these available for students/ECRs that are keen to attend either (or both) events and are financially struggling to do so. This is primarily aimed at those in this community who do not have access to resources, to go toward travel, accommodation, or registration at both events – this will be capped at £250 per applicant. Given that both events take place in September, I'll be accepting applications until the end of August.
