How to find us

Lancaster University is set in 560 acres of beautiful parkland and lies approximately three miles south of the City of Lancaster. The campus is easily accessible via road, rail and is within 70 miles of Manchester's International Airport.

By Car

If using Sat Nav, we recommend the postcode **LA1 4YW**. Leave the M6 motorway at junction 33 and take the A6 north towards Lancaster.

After Galgate village, three junctions with traffic lights on the A6 serve the University. Turn right at the second set of traffic lights into the main University drive (Bigforth Drive). Take the third exit on the roundabout and then the first left onto **Library Avenue**. Our Student Ambassadors will direct you either to the departmental check-in location or to the campus tours. An interactive campus map can be found using the QR code at the bottom of this sheet.

By Rail

There are direct rail links between Lancaster and many of the UK's major cities and airports. The nearest bus stop to the University is on Common Garden Street or from the bus station (see below). If you prefer taxis, these are available from outside the station at the northbound platform.

By Bus

Lancaster Bus Station is situated on Damside Street in the city centre and most bus services also stop at Common Garden Street. Service 1/1A provides a direct connection to the University around every 10 minutes. Services 100, 4, 4X, 40, 41 and 42 also serve the University. Most of these buses stop at the University Bus Station, underneath Alexandra Square. Look out for our Student Ambassadors to help direct you. Please note that some of services 40 and 41 only stop on the A6 outside the main University drive.

By Air

From Manchester International Airport take the M56 motorway at junction 5 and join the M6 motorway at junction 20 (north). Follow the directions 'By Car'. An hourly direct rail link runs between the airport and Lancaster.
