Applications for this award should:

- Have been business incorporated for 12 months or less at the point they engaged with Eco-I NW?
- Evidence in their nomination that they have big ambitions in the innovation and low carbon space.
- Show that the business is on a trajectory to some of the below listed achievements in the next 12 months e.g., new products/services launched, increase in turnover/staff, promising and large-scale R&D underway, entering new markets/territories
- Show that they are collaborative in nature?
- Evidence if equitable partnerships been established through project work on Eco-I NW
- Show what has been achieved to date.

Low Carbon Achievements

As a result of your engagement and collaboration with Eco-I NW, what has your business achieved or set about achieving in the low carbon innovation space? E.g.:

- Achieved or anticipated CO2e reduction
- New products/services launched.
- Increase in turnover.
- Jobs created.
- Promising and large-scale R&D underway
- Entering new markets/territories with low carbon products/services.

Project Impact and Future Commitment to Low Carbon

- As a result of your collaboration with Eco-I NW, what are the next steps for your business specifically in relation to low carbon.
- What are your ambitions in the short, medium and long term for the business in the low carbon space?
