

Guidelines for Visiting Scholars

Visiting Scholars to the Faculty of Humanities, Arts & Social Sciences are welcome to attend modules that are part of the chosen discipline's postgraduate curriculum. However, please consider carefully the following conditions.

1. If you are interested in attending a module, please complete an enrolment form and have your discipline contact person approve and sign it. The form then needs to be returned to the Research & Engagement team. If you do not officially register for the module, you will not be able to access the materials online.
2. You can register for up to two postgraduate modules per term.
3. Being enrolled onto a module is dependent on space. You might not be able to attend a module if the module is full.
4. Once you have registered for the module, you will be expected to attend all lecture sessions*, unless there are unforeseen circumstances (e.g. illness). Please inform the module convenor if you are unable to attend a session. We keep attendance records in each module.
5. In order to receive a Confirmation of Attendance letter, you will need to have attended at least 6 out of 9 sessions of the module.

Attending Research Groups

Visiting Scholars are encouraged to attend the talks and workshops organized by the discipline's research groups. However, in order to do so, please contact the coordinator of the research group in question to ensure that you have all the relevant information and that you are subscribed to the appropriate mailing-lists.
