







Participation Summary for the IBPI Trial

What is IBPI?

- IBPI stands for the "Integrated Bipolar Parenting Intervention"
- It is a new online support programme for parents with bipolar disorder
- It contains 9 interactive modules that focus on integrating bipolar self-management techniques with parenting advice
- Accessible from any computer or mobile device
- Available to users 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

What is the study about?

- IBPI has been co-created with parents with bipolar
- Its aim is to help people with bipolar with their parenting.
- We are testing to see if using IBPI is helpful for parents with bipolar by measuring its ability to:
 - Improve children's behavioural and emotional outcomes
 - Reduce parent's stress and anxiety
 - Improve parent's mood symptoms
 - o Improve parenting confidence and competence
 - Improve overall family functioning
- We are also testing the cost effectiveness of IBPI

What will I be asked to do?

- All studies activities will be completed <u>online</u>, which means you can participate fully from the comfort of your own home
- Participation will last for approximately 1 year, during which you will be asked to:
 - 1. Complete an initial screening interview (10 20 minutes)
 - 2. Complete an eligibility check interview (30 minutes 2 hours, depending on how much you want to share)
 - 3. Complete questionnaires at 0, 24, and 48 weeks (45 minutes)
 - 4. Access IBPI as often as you like and follow your treatment as usual **OR** just follow your treatment as usual (randomly assigned)
- Participants assigned to the group with access to IBPI will also be invited to complete a feedback survey. Some of these will be invited to a feedback interview.

What will I receive?

- Payment for your time: £60-100 in total for completing interviews and questionnaires
- Support to complete assessments (if required)
- The chance to contribute to research aiming to improve the lives of other parents with bipolar and their children
