



NERC Core budget 22/23




Role of environment in health benefits of connecting with nature

Funding opportunity led by AHRC



Phase 1

£1.5m to fund 12 pilot projects (commencing January 2022).

Phase 2

£3m to fund 12 consortium-building projects (to begin 1st November 2022).


Phase 3

Estimated £20m to fund up to 10 consortia (beginning November 2023 for 3 years).

- NERC led a cross-sector workshop earlier this year to discuss what planetary health research themes should be tackled, the UK strengths and where we can add value. A report was published as a result of the workshop.
- Key recommendations include the development of a planetary health funding opportunity to advance approaches, innovation and methodologies.
- NERC now seeks to gain views from the wider community – survey open until 30th September 2022.

Summary

- Promotion of an healthy environment is integral part of UKRI strategy and NERC delivery plan.
- NERC will continue to fund both curiosity-driven and strategic research.
- Funding opportunity led by AHRC "Mobilising Community Assets to Tackle Health Disparities".
- Planetary Health represents an area of scoping (very early discussion, with no funding opportunities at present).
