Scope and Content: 5 photographic albums created by the Holden family in the early 20th century. Features images taken around Lancaster, Forton, Morecambe, Lake District and Carlise.

History: The family lived at Jackon Hill, Forton until 1900. Later moved to Lune Bank Hall until 1909. The albums were donated to the Library in the early 2000s by Miss A Holden of Leyland. The collection wasn't accessioned until 2025.
