Introduction

The Jack Hylton Collection held by Special Collections and Archives at Lancaster University comprises the business papers of Jack Hylton (1892-1965), pianist, composer, band leader and impresario.

The Collection contains 'TV Parts' created by Jack Hylton for the TV programmes he produced between 1955-1959 for Associated-Rediffusion (A-R), one of the early independent TV companies in the UK. The parts contain musical arrangements which give instructions for each member of the band for a particular musical composition used in Hylton's TV productions. The parts were arranged by number, but in this list have been arranged by show.
