

Applying for a short course

To apply for a short course offered by the Department of Linguistics and English Language, you need to create a user account to make your application.

2. Read the application information in the sections **Before you apply** and **Applications for 2024 entry**.

If you are applying for a short course in the academic year 2024/25 – i.e., October 2024 to July 2025 – this information applies to you. If you are applying for a short course in the academic year 2023/24 – e.g., starting in April 2024 – you are strongly recommended to contact us directly, as well as submitting an application (see below). Information on the application pages is now focused on applications to start in September 2024, for academic year 2024/25, but it is still possible to apply for courses starting between now and then.

3. Click **Create an account** and complete your details.

Select as your chosen level of study **Postgraduate Taught (e.g. MA, MSc, LLM)**.

 The start dates are for academic year 2024/25. If you want to apply for academic year
 - 2023/24 (e.g., starting in April 2024), you may or may not find the option given. You should: a) select whatever date is available for the course this will allow you to complete and submit the application.
