## How to find us

---

Lancaster University is set in 560 acres of beautiful parkland and lies approximately three miles south of the City of Lancaster. The campus is easily accessible via road, rail and is within 70 miles of Manchester's International Airport.

### By Car

If using Sat Nav, we recommend the postcode **LA1 4AT**. Leave the M6 motorway at junction 33 and take the A6 north towards Lancaster. You can also use the What 3 Words website or app <https://what3words.com/>. Using “**skillet.droplet.wider**” will take you to our Welcome Desk in Health Innovation One.

After Galgate village, three junctions with traffic lights on the A6 serve the University. Turn right at the third set of traffic lights onto Sir John Fisher Drive and park at the **Health Innovation Campus car park**. **Do not turn onto Bigforth Drive (second set of traffic lights), which serve the main campus.** Parking is free. An interactive campus map can be found using the QR code at the bottom of this sheet.

### By Rail

There are direct rail links between Lancaster and many of the UK's major cities and airports. The nearest bus stop to the University is on Common Garden Street or from the bus station (see below). If you prefer taxis, these are available from outside the station at the northbound platform.

### By Bus

Lancaster Bus Station is situated on Damside Street in the city centre and most bus services also stop at Common Garden Street. Service 1/1A provides a direct connection to the University around every 10 minutes. Services 100, 4, 4X, 40, 41 and 42 also serve the University. You should alight at the Health Innovation Campus bus stop, on the A6, and head up Sir John Fisher Drive to the Health Innovation One building.

### By Air

From Manchester International Airport take the M56 motorway at junction 5 and join the M6 motorway at junction 20 (north). Follow the directions 'By Car'. An hourly direct rail link runs between the airport and Lancaster.
