

Foreign Influence Registration Scheme assessment: Level 1 - Initial Triage

'political influence activities"


Actions intended to affect UK policy or elections, inc papers, lobbying, media

*Key terms:

Arrangement

Any type of agreement, whether formal or informal. Could include a contract, memorandum of understanding (MOU) or quid proquo informal agreement or arrangement.

See further details of the types of arrangements under the <u>political tier</u> and arrangements under the <u>enhanced tier</u>.

Direction

An order or instruction with an obligation or compulsion to comply, either through the provision of funding, application of coercion, or other formal or informal means.

Foreign Power

Sovereign, government, or agencies representing government.

Further details in <u>Section 32</u> of the National Security Act 2023

Specificed Foreign Power

A foreign power which has been specified through regulations under the enhanced tier.

Currently (Aug 2025) the States of Russia and Iran.

Relevant activities

<u>political influence activities</u> - Actions intended to affect UK policy or elections, inc. papers, lobbying, media, communication activities, public communication activities or the provision of money, goods or services,
